## HOUSE BILL No. 1428

## DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 27-8-11-15; IC 27-13-15-8.
Synopsis: Renewal of insurance coverage. Requires insurers offering policies of accident and sickness insurance and health maintenance organizations to provide an insured an additional 30 days from the date: (1) a preferred provider agreement or a participating provider contract is terminated; or (2) the insurer or health maintenance organization and a preferred provider or participating provider are required to complete the renegotiation of an agreement or a contract; to make a decision on the renewal of coverage under a policy of accident and sickness insurance or a health maintenance organization contract.

Effective: July 1, 2021.

## HOUSE BILL No. 1428

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning insurance.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

SECTION 1. IC 27-8-11-15 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE AS A NEW SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2021]: Sec. 15. (a) As used in this section, "preferred provider" means a provider that has entered into a preferred provider agreement.
(b) As used in this section, "preferred provider agreement" means an agreement entered into under section 3 of this chapter.
(c) This section applies when a preferred provider agreement is:
(1) canceled by an insurer;
(2) not renewed by an insurer; or
(3) being renegotiated by an insurer and a preferred provider.
(d) An insurer must provide an additional thirty (30) days after the date:
(1) a preferred provider agreement is terminated due to the insurer canceling or not renewing the agreement; or
(2) the insurer and preferred provider are required to complete the renegotiation of the terms of a preferred
provider agreement;
for an insured to make a decision on the renewal of coverage under a policy of accident and sickness insurance.

SECTION 2. IC 27-13-15-8 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE AS A NEW SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2021]: Sec. 8. (a) This section applies when a participating provider contract entered into under this chapter is:
(1) canceled by a health maintenance organization;
(2) not renewed by a health maintenance organization; or
(3) being renegotiated by a health maintenance organization and a participating provider.
(b) A health maintenance organization must provide an additional thirty (30) days after the date:
(1) a participating provider contract is terminated due to the health maintenance organization canceling or not renewing the contract; or
(2) the health maintenance organization and participating provider are required to complete the renegotiation of the terms of a participating provider contract;
for a group contract holder or an individual insured under an individual contract to make a decision on the renewal of coverage under a health maintenance organization contract.
