## **HOUSE BILL No. 1460**

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning taxation.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1	SECTION 1. IC 6-2.5-5-51 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE
2	AS A NEW SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY
3	1,2017]: Sec. 51. (a) As used in this section, "ammunition" includes
4	cartridges and shotgun shells for use in a firearm.
5	(b) As used in this section, "firearm" means a shotgun, rifle,
6	pistol, revolver, or other handgun.
7	(c) Transactions involving the sale of:
8	(1) a firearm; or
9	(2) ammunition;
10	are exempt from the state gross retail tax.
