

# HOUSE BILL No. 1483

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## DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

**Citations Affected:** IC 4-35-7-19.

**Synopsis:** Table games at racetrack casinos. Changes the date range to between July 1, 2019, and September 30, 2019, during which a racetrack licensee may submit a plan to the gaming commission for conducting wagering on table games at the racetrack's gambling game facility.

**Effective:** July 1, 2019.

## HOUSE BILL No. 1483

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning gaming.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:*

- 1 SECTION 1. IC 4-35-7-19, AS ADDED BY P.L.255-2015,  
2 SECTION 42, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE  
3 JULY 1, 2019]: Sec. 19. (a) After ~~March 1, 2021~~, **June 30, 2019**, and  
4 before ~~June 30, 2021~~, **October 1, 2019**, a licensee may submit a plan  
5 to the commission for conducting wagering on table games at the  
6 licensee's gambling game facility. The commission shall consider a  
7 plan submitted under this subsection within forty-five (45) days of  
8 receiving the plan.  
9 (b) In making its determination to authorize wagering on table  
10 games, the commission shall consider the potential:  
11 (1) economic benefits;  
12 (2) tax revenue;  
13 (3) number of new jobs; and  
14 (4) capital investments;  
15 that could occur if the commission authorizes wagering on table games  
16 based on a plan submitted under subsection (a).  
17 (c) After considering a plan submitted under subsection (a) and the



1 criteria described in subsection (b), the commission may authorize  
2 wagering on table games at the licensee's gambling game facility.  
3 (d) A licensee may not:  
4 (1) install more gambling games than the number of gambling  
5 games proposed in the table game plan submitted to the  
6 commission; and  
7 (2) offer more than two thousand two hundred (2,200) gambling  
8 games as provided under section 11(b) of this chapter.
