# HOUSE BILL No. 1496

DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 7.1-3-27-5.

**Synopsis:** Artisan distillers. Provides that an applicant for an artisan distiller's permit must hold a farm winery, brewer's, or distiller's permit for one year (instead of three years) before the date of the application.

Effective: July 1, 2017.

## **HOUSE BILL No. 1496**

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning alcohol and tobacco.

### Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

9	(A) A farm winery permit under IC 7.1-3-12.
10	(B) A brewer's permit issued under IC 7.1-3-2-2(b).
11	(C) A distiller's permit under IC 7.1-3-7.
12	(2) The permit applicant may not have more than one (1) violation
13	of this title during the three (3) year period immediately preceding
14	the date of the application.
15	(3) (2) The permit applicant may not have any violation of this
16	title during the twelve (12) month one (1) year period
17	immediately preceding the date of the permit application.



(b) As used in this subsection, "qualifying permit" means a farm
winery, brewer's, or distiller's permit under subsection (a)(1)(A),
(a)(1)(B), or (a)(1)(C) that is required in order to hold an artisan
distiller's permit. The same persons must directly or indirectly own and
control more than fifty percent (50%) of the entity that holds the
qualifying permit and the artisan distiller's permit.
