## HOUSE ENROLLED ACT No. 1501

AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning agriculture and animals.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

SECTION 1. IC 15-16-10-3, AS ADDED BY P.L.23-2009, SECTION 1, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2015]: Sec. 3. The invasive species council is established within the Purdue University School College of Agriculture.

SECTION 2. IC 15-16-10-11, AS ADDED BY P.L.23-2009, SECTION 1, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2015]: Sec. 11. The Purdue University School College of Agriculture shall provide administrative assistance to the council.

SECTION 3. IC 15-16-10-13, AS ADDED BY P.L.23-2009, SECTION 1, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JUNE 30, 2015]: Sec. 13. This chapter expires July 1, 2015. 2023.
