## DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 21-41.5.

**Synopsis:** Housing for students in foster care. Provides that a state educational institution shall establish a program to allow foster youth students of the state educational institution to live in campus housing between academic terms.

Effective: July 1, 2019.

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning higher education.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

16	(b) A foster youth student must verify that he or she is a foster
17	youth in a manner prescribed by the state educational institution.

1 (c) The state educational institution may charge a foster youth student for the campus housing required under this section at a reduced charge.
