Synopsis: Free state park admission for veterans. Requires the department of natural resources to provide free admission to state parks to veterans with the proper identification.

HOUSE BILL No. 1556

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning natural and cultural resources.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1	SECTION 1. IC 14-8-2-296.5 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA
2	CODE AS A NEW SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS
3	[EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2025]: Sec. 296.5. "Veteran", for purposes of
4	IC 14-19-3-1.5, means an individual who:
5	(1) has served in:
6	(A) the armed forces of the United States or their reserves
7	(B) the Indiana Army National Guard; or
8	(C) the Indiana Air National Guard; and
9	(2) was released from active duty under conditions other than
10	dishonorable.
11	SECTION 2. IC 14-19-3-1.5 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE
12	AS A NEW SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY
13	1, 2025]: Sec. 1.5. (a) The department shall admit and may not
14	charge an admission fee for use of an Indiana state park to:
15	(1) an individual who is:
16	(A) a veteran; and
17	(B) an Indiana resident; and



1	(2) the individual's:
2	(A) motor vehicle; and
3	(B) passengers.
4	The individual must present an item described in subsection (c) for
5	the department to verify that the individual meets the
6	requirements of this subsection.
7	(b) Free admittance to a state park is limited to an individual
8	described in subsection (a) and not more than five (5) occupants in
9	a vehicle entering with the individual.
10	(c) The following items may be used to verify that an individual
11	qualifies for admission under subsection (a):
12	(1) A United States Uniformed Services Retiree Identification
13	Card.
14	(2) A DD 214 or DD 215 record.
15	(3) United States military discharge papers.
16	(4) A credential issued to the individual that contains an
17	indication of veteran status under IC 9-24-11-5.5 or
18	IC 9-24-16-3.
19	(5) Any other identification approved by the department, in
20	consultation with the Indiana department of veterans' affairs
21	established by IC 10-17-1-2.
