## **HOUSE BILL No. 1580**

## DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

**Citations Affected:** IC 5-10-8-21; IC 27-8-35; IC 27-13-7-24.

**Synopsis:** Coverage for ectodermal dysplasia treatment. Requires a state employee health plan, a policy of accident and sickness insurance, and a contract with a health maintenance organization to provide coverage for treatment of ectodermal dysplasia.

Effective: July 1, 2019.

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning insurance.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:
