HOUSE BILL No. 1582

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning pensions.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

SECTION 1. IC 5-10-8.5-16, AS AMENDED BY P.L.229-201.
SECTION 75, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIV
JULY 1, 2015]: Sec. 16. (a) Except as provided in subsection (f), if
participant meets all of the following conditions, the participant
entitled to receive an additional contribution credited to the
participant's subaccount and computed as described in subsection (b
(1) The participant is:
(A) on the participant's last day of service with the participant
employer, eligible for and has applied to receive a norma
unreduced retirement benefit from the public employe
retirement fund of which the participant is a member; or
(B) on the participant's last day of service, an elected of
appointed officer.
(2) After June 30, 2007, and before July 1, 2017, January 1 :
2018, the participant terminates service:



1	(A) from the employer; or
2	(B) as an elected or appointed officer.
3	(3) By the participant's last day of service, the participant has
4	completed:
5	(A) fifteen (15) years of service with the employer; or
6	(B) ten (10) years of service as an elected or appointed officer.
7	(b) The amount of the contribution to a participant's subaccount
8	under this section is the product of:
9	(1) the participant's years of service (rounded down to the nearest
10	whole year):
11	(A) with the participant's employer, determined on the
12	participant's last day of service with the participant's employer;
13	or
14	(B) as an elected or appointed officer, determined on the
15	participant's last day of service as an elected or appointed
16	officer; multiplied by
17	(2) one thousand dollars (\$1,000).
18	(c) For a participant who has service with more than one (1)
19	employer, the participant's years of service used in the computation
20	under subsection (b)(1) is the sum of all of the participant's years of
21	service.
22	(d) The participant's employer must credit the additional
23	contribution made under this section to the participant's subaccount not
24	later than sixty (60) days after the participant's last day of service.
25	(e) A participant who meets the requirements to receive an
26	additional contribution under this section may receive the additional
27	contribution only once, regardless of the participant's employment after
28	the payment of the additional contribution.
29	(f) An additional contribution under this section shall not be made
30	after June 30, 2011, to any of the following participants:
31	(1) A conservation officer of the department of natural resources.
32	(2) An employee of the state excise police.
33	(3) An employee of the state police department, other than the
34	following:
35	(A) An employee of the state police department who waived
36	coverage under a common and unified plan of self-insurance
37	under IC 5-10-8-6 before July 1, 2011.
38	(B) An employee of the state police department who makes an
39	election under IC 5-10-8.5-9.5.
40	(C) An employee of the state police department who makes an
41	election under IC 5-10-8.5-9.6.
42	(g) This section expires July 1, 2017. January 15, 2018.
