

HOUSE BILL No. 1614

DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 33-37-5-9.

Synopsis: Court fees. Requires a court to assess a drug abuse, prosecution, interdiction, and correction fee against a person who is convicted of certain legend drug offenses.

Effective: July 1, 2019.

HOUSE BILL No. 1614

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning courts and court officers.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1 SECTION 1. IC 33-37-5-9 IS AMENDED TO READ AS
2 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2019]: Sec. 9. (a) This section
3 applies to criminal actions.

4 (b) The court shall assess a drug abuse, prosecution, interdiction,
5 and correction fee of at least two hundred dollars (\$200) and not more
6 than one thousand dollars (\$1,000) against a person convicted of an
7 offense under IC 35-48-4 **or IC 16-42-19**.

8 (c) In determining the amount of the drug abuse, prosecution,
9 interdiction, and correction fee assessed against a person under
10 subsection (b), a court shall consider the person's ability to pay the fee.

11 (d) The clerk shall collect the drug abuse, prosecution, interdiction,
12 and correction fee set by the court when a person is convicted of an
13 offense under IC 35-48-4 **or IC 16-42-19**.
