DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 14-22-12-7.3.

Synopsis: Lifetime hunting and fishing licenses. Requires the department of natural resources to issue to residents of Indiana and nonresidents of Indiana who own land in Indiana lifetime licenses to hunt, fish, or trap. Requires the natural resources commission to adopt fees for lifetime licenses to hunt, fish, or trap.

Effective: July 1, 2015.

HOUSE BILL No. 1629

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning natural and cultural resources.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1	SECTION 1. IC 14-22-12-7.3, AS ADDED BY P.L.219-2014,
2	SECTION 26, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
3	JULY 1, 2015]: Sec. 7.3. (a) Subject to the commission adopting fees
4	under subsection (b), the department may shall issue to:
5	(1) residents of Indiana; or
6	(2) nonresidents of Indiana who own land in Indiana;
7	upon application, lifetime licenses to hunt, fish, or trap.
8	(b) The commission may shall adopt rules under IC 4-22-2 and
9	IC 14-10-2-4 to establish fees for lifetime licenses to hunt, fish, or trap.
10	(c) The fees adopted under subsection (b) shall be twenty-five
11	percent (25%) of the cost of an annual license to hunt, fish, or trap
12	over a thirty (30) year period.
