DIGEST OF HB 1635 (Updated March 11, 2015 1:49 pm - DI 116)

Citations Affected: IC 20-20.

Synopsis: Dual language immersion pilot program. Establishes the dual language immersion pilot program to provide assistance to school corporations and charter schools that establish dual language immersion programs in certain foreign languages.

Effective: July 1, 2015.

ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL No. 1635

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning education.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1	SECTION 1. IC 20-20-41 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE
2	AS A NEW CHAPTER TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
3	JULY 1, 2015]:
4	Chapter 41. Dual Language Pilot Program
5	Sec. 1. The department, with the approval of the state board
6	shall establish and maintain a dual language immersion pilot
7	program to assist school corporations and charter schools to
8	establish dual language immersion programs in:
9	(1) Chinese;
10	(2) Spanish;
11	(3) French; or
12	(4) any other language approved by the department.
13	Sec. 2. A school corporation or charter school may be eligible to
14	participate in the dual language pilot program under this chapter
15	if:



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1	(1) the school corporation or charter school uses an
2	instructional model that provides at least fifty percent (50%)
3	of its instruction in English and fifty percent (50%) of its
4	instruction in a language described in section 1 of this
5	chapter;
6	(2) the program that uses an instructional model described in
7	subdivision (1) begins either in kindergarten or in grade 1;
8	and
9	(3) the program described in subdivision (2) meets any other
10	requirements established by the department.
