## **HOUSE BILL No. 1637**

### DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 3-5-5-7.

**Synopsis:** College student voting. Removes the option of a student attending a postsecondary educational institution in Indiana to state the student's residence for purposes of voting as either: (1) the address where the student lives when the student attends the postsecondary educational institution where the student pursues the student's education; or (2) the address where the student lives when the student is not attending the postsecondary educational institution where the student pursues the student's education.

Effective: January 1, 2020.

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning elections.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

9	(4) other purposes;
0	without the intent of making a permanent home in the precinct.
1	(b) The following apply to a student attending a postsecondary
2	educational institution in Indiana:
3	(1) A student who applies to register to vote shall state the
4	student's residence address.
5	(2) A student has only one (1) residence for purposes of this title.
6	(3) A student may state the student's residence as either of the
7	following, but not both:



1	(A) The address where the student lives when the student
2	attends the postsecondary educational institution where the
3	student pursues the student's education.
4	(B) The address where the student lives when the student is
5	not attending the postsecondary educational institution where
5	the student pursues the student's education.
