4	Whereas, The FFA national organization, established in
5	1928, and Indiana FFA, established in 1929, have prepared
6	future generations for the challenges of feeding a growing
7	population;
8	Whereas, The National FFA encompasses the 50 states and
9	two U.S. territories and continues to grow, with 653,359
0	members and 8,568 local chapters, while the Indiana FFA
1	membership has grown to more than 12,200 members in 209
2	chapters;
3	Whereas, The FFA motto of "Learning to Do, Doing to Learn,
4	Earning to Live, Living to Serve" has been upheld and applied
5	by the organization by focusing on the individual student and
6	providing a path to achievement in premier leadership,
7	personal growth, and career success through agricultural
8	education;
9	Whereas, The organization's directive is to develop
20	agricultural leaders, increase awareness of the importance of
21	agriculture, strengthen the confidence of the students involved,
22	promote the choice of agriculture as a career, encourage
23	agricultural experience programs, highlight wise management
24	of community resources, develop members' interpersonal skills
25	and character, promote cooperation and healthy lifestyles, and
