2 Alzheimer's Association's Indiana State Advocacy Day.

3 *Whereas, There is an estimated 110,000 Hoosiers living with*
4 *Alzheimer's disease and 115,000 unpaid Indiana dementia*
5 *caregivers;*

6 *Whereas, The mission of the Alzheimer's Association is to*
7 *eliminate Alzheimer's disease through the advancement of*
8 *research, to provide and enhance care and support for all*
9 *affected, and to reduce the risk of dementia through the*
10 *promotion of brain health;*

11 *Whereas, The Alzheimer's Association is the leading voice for*
12 *Alzheimer's disease and dementia advocacy, fighting for*
13 *Alzheimer's research, prevention, and care initiatives, and*
14 *successfully bringing people together to tackle the challenge of*
15 *Alzheimer's disease;*

16 *Whereas, The Alzheimer's Association, Greater Indiana*
17 *Chapter provides services in 73 counties and has a network of*
18 *over 400 Hoosier volunteers who deliver, connect, and fund the*
19 *mission;*

20 *Whereas, The Alzheimer's Association's Indiana State*
21 *Advocacy Day organizes, trains, and connects Hoosier*
22 *Alzheimer's advocates with their state legislators, compelling*
23 *our leaders to engage in the fight to make Indiana more*
24 *dementia capable;*

25 *Whereas, In memory of those who have lost their lives to*



1 *Alzheimer's and in honor of those currently living with the*
2 *disease, Association volunteers join together to advocate for*
3 *legislation that will better the lives of individuals, families,*
4 *caregivers, and communities in Indiana impacted by*
5 *Alzheimer's disease; and*

6 *Whereas, Hoosier Alzheimer's advocates are working towards*
7 *a vision of a world without Alzheimer's disease and all other*
8 *dementia: Therefore,*

9 *Be it resolved by the House of Representatives*
10 *of the General Assembly of the State of Indiana,*
11 *the Senate concurring:*

12 SECTION 1. That the Indiana General Assembly recognizes
13 the Alzheimer's Association, Greater Indiana Chapter for the
14 services they provide to Indiana constituents.

15 SECTION 2. That the Principal Clerk of the House of
16 Representatives transmit a copy of this resolution to the
17 Alzheimer's Association, Greater Indiana Chapter and
18 participants in Indiana State Advocacy Day.
