A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION urging the Indiana 1 Department of Transportation to rename that section of U.S. 2 Highway 30 from the intersection with Pioneer Road in 3 Plymouth to the intersection with Oak Road in Marshall County 4 the "Ralph 'Ray' Reed, Jr. Memorial Drive". 5 Whereas, Indiana State Police Master Motor Carrier 6 Inspector Ralph "Ray" Reed, Jr. was struck and killed on U.S. 7 30 in Marshall County on August 3, 1995; 8 9 Whereas, At the time of his death, Master Motor Carrier 10 Inspector Reed had stopped to inspect a tractor-trailer; Whereas, As Inspector Reed walked around the semi, an 11 oncoming tractor-trailer hauling cattle struck and killed him, 12 making him the first Indiana State Police Motor Carrier 13 Inspector to be killed in the line of duty; 14 Whereas, Since his death, the Indiana State Police 15 Commercial Vehicle Enforcement Division has honored Ralph 16 Reed, Jr. by recognizing annually a motor carrier inspector 17 who excels in his or her work and demonstrates the qualities of 18 19 a model employee; Whereas, Ralph "Ray" Reed, Jr. was appointed as an Indiana 20 State Police Motor Carrier Inspector on April 16, 1968, serving 21 27 years and three months as an Indiana State Police Motor 22 Carrier Inspector; and 23

Whereas, Master Motor Carrier Inspector Ralph "Ray" Reed,
Jr. gave his life in service to his state and deserves special
