6	Whereas, On December 13, 2018, a local resident placed an
7	emergency call and notified police that an armed individual
8	was on his way to Dennis Intermediate School in Richmond,
9	Indiana, with the intention of causing violence;
10	Whereas, School staff, public safety officers, and elected
11	officials were prepared, relied on established plans, and acted
12	decisively and bravely in accordance with their training;
13	Whereas, School staff at Dennis Intermediate School initiated
14	lockdown procedures shortly after being informed of a potential
15	threat;
16	Whereas, Teachers and staff quickly escorted students to
17	secure classrooms and all access to the building was locked to
18	prevent entry;
19	Whereas, Police arrived at Dennis Intermediate School and
20	confronted an individual who shot the glass out of a locked
21	door to gain entry into the building;
22	Whereas, Police risked their own lives as the individual fired
23	at them and pursued the individual into a locked stairwell
24	where the individual took his own life;

1	Whereas, No injuries were reported by students, school staff,
2	faculty, or police during or after the confrontation; and
3	Whereas, The readiness and response by city, county, and
4	school officials, staff, and faculty prevented greater loss of life
5	at Dennis Intermediate School and the surrounding areas:
6	Therefore,
7	Be it resolved by the House of Representatives
8	of the General Assembly of the State of Indiana,
