1	A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION petitioning the United
2	States Department of Transportation to hold hearings on the
3	placement of the entire state of Indiana in the same time zone.
4	Whereas, The Uniform Time Act of 1966 (15 U.S.C. 260 et
5	seq.) delegates to the Secretary of the United States Department
6	of Transportation the responsibility of designating standard
7	time zones in the United States;
8	Whereas, Indiana is presently divided between the Central
9	Time Zone and the Eastern Time Zone;
10	Whereas, Light maps should be consulted in order to pick the
11	best time zone for the state of Indiana;
12	Whereas, The observance of time in the Central Time Zone
13	would return most of Indiana to normal times for daylight and
14	darkness;
15	Whereas, Relocation of the time zone boundary will provide
16	that most Hoosiers will observe the same time year round;
17	Whereas, Request for changes in the designated time zones
18	must be made by a local unit of government or a state
19	government to the Secretary of the United States Department of
20	Transportation;
21	Whereas, The Secretary of the United States Department of
22	Transportation may make changes in time zone boundaries,
23	subject to public hearings in the communities affected, at the
24	request of the highest political authority of the state;
