1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION urging the Indiana
2 Department of Transportation to rename a portion of State Road
3 67 the "Trooper Bob Garrison Memorial Highway" in honor of
4 Trooper Robert Jack Garrison.

5 *Whereas, Trooper Robert "Bob" Garrison was born on May*
6 *29, 1932, to Goldie and William Garrison;*

7 *Whereas, Trooper Garrison met his wife, Louise (Phillips)*
8 *Garrison, while they attended high school, and the two married*
9 *shortly after graduation on November 9, 1951;*

10 *Whereas, Trooper Garrison was a U.S. Army veteran of the*
11 *Korean War and served as a military policeman;*

12 *Whereas, Trooper Garrison earned his place with the Indiana*
13 *State Police in 1955 and later patrolled Delaware County with*
14 *his fellow troopers;*

15 *Whereas, At the age of 27, Trooper Garrison passed away*
16 *from injuries that he sustained during a traffic accident on*
17 *State Road 67 while responding to a call to help an injured*
18 *child;*

19 *Whereas, A tribute published in the Muncie Evening Press on*
20 *December 16, 1959, stated that, "Garrison had a real zest for*
21 *life—a buoyance which made him a genuine friend, in the true*
22 *sense of friendship", and lauded his sincerity, integrity, and*
23 *devotion as a police officer;*

24 *Whereas, Trooper Garrison was survived by his wife, two*



1 *sons, daughter, brothers, sisters, and parents;*

2 *Whereas, It is fitting that the Indiana General Assembly*
3 *recognize Trooper Garrison's service to Indiana and honor his*
4 *name on behalf of his loved ones and descendants; and*

5 *Whereas, The Indiana General Assembly urges the Indiana*
6 *Department of Transportation to rename a portion of State*
7 *Road 67 the "Trooper Bob Garrison Memorial Highway" in*
8 *memory of Trooper Garrison's service to Delaware County and*
9 *the state of Indiana: Therefore,*

10 *Be it resolved by the House of Representatives*
11 *of the General Assembly of the State of Indiana,*
12 *the Senate concurring:*

13 SECTION 1. That the Indiana General Assembly urges the
14 Indiana Department of Transportation to rename a portion of
15 State Road 67 where State Road 67 intersects South
16 Honeycreek Road and South Cowan Road in Delaware County
17 the "Trooper Bob Garrison Memorial Highway" to honor
18 Trooper Garrison and remember his service to Delaware
19 County, the state of Indiana, and the United States of America.

20 SECTION 2. That the Principal Clerk of the House of
21 Representatives transmit copies of this resolution to the family
22 of Trooper Garrison and the Commissioner of the Indiana
23 Department of Transportation.
