5           *international awards to date for their participation in various*

7           *Whereas, The World School Children's Art Exhibition is held*  
8           *to promote mutual understanding and friendship among the*  
9           *younger generations of the world through the exchange of*  
10           *children's artwork;*

11           *Whereas, The exhibition is organized by the Association for*  
12           *Education through Art, the Republic of China, and the*  
13           *Association of Formative Art Education for the Republic of*  
14           *China;*

15           *Whereas, The exhibition is open to school children ages 6*  
16           *through 15 and the students from Whitko High School*  
17           *participated in the 49th World School Children's Art Exhibition*  
18           *in the Republic of China, Taipei;*

19           *Whereas, The 49th World School Children's Art Exhibition*  
20           *included student artwork from 41 countries;*

21           *Whereas, Whitko High School art students were honored with*  
22           *nine selected certificates and two bronze medals;*

23           *Whereas, Recognized participants had their artwork*  
24           *displayed in Taipei and were featured in an art booklet sent*

2 *Whereas, Whitko High School art students represented their*  
3 *school, community, and the United States of America;*

4 *Whereas, Whitko High School won 11 of the total 32 awards*  
5 *received by U.S. contributors;*

6 *Whereas, Whitko High School art teacher Mr. Daniel Malicki*  
7 *is proud of his students' dedication and pursuit of excellence;*
