4 *Whereas, The year 2019 marks the 107th anniversary of*
5 *Girl Scouts of the USA, which is the largest and most successful*
6 *leadership program for girls in the world;*

7 *Whereas, Girl Scouts combines time-tested,*
8 *researched-backed methods with exciting, modern*
9 *programming that speaks to today's girls and is designed to*
10 *cater to the strengths of the girls' leadership development;*

11 *Whereas, Girl Scouts offers girls 21st century programming*
12 *in science, technology, engineering, and math; the outdoors;*
13 *entrepreneurship; and many more learning opportunities to*
14 *help girls develop invaluable life and leadership skills;*

15 *Whereas, Girl Scouts is a premiere leadership organization*
16 *for girls and welcomes girls of all backgrounds and interests*
17 *who want to develop the courage, confidence, and character to*
18 *make the world a better place;*

19 *Whereas, Research shows that girls learn best in an all-girl,*
20 *girl-led environment in which their specific needs are*
21 *addressed and met;*

22 *Whereas, The Girl Scout Gold Award, the highest and most*
23 *prestigious award in Girl Scouting, calls on Girls Scouts in*
24 *grades 9 to 12 to take on projects that have a measurable and*
25 *sustainable impact on a community by first assessing a need,*



1 *designing a solution, completing a project, and inspiring others*
2 *for sustainment;*

3 *Whereas, Girl Scouts brings over 100 years of experience and*
4 *a wealth of knowledge to programs that deliver girls*
5 *cornerstone experiences with benefits that last a lifetime; and*

6 *Whereas, More than 50 million women are Girl Scout*
7 *alumnae, and 2.6 million girls and adults are current members:*
8 *Therefore,*

9 *Be it resolved by the House of Representatives*
10 *of the General Assembly of the State of Indiana,*
11 *the Senate concurring:*

12 SECTION 1. That the Indiana General Assembly recognizes
13 Girl Scout Day at the Statehouse on March 19, 2019.

14 SECTION 2. That the Indiana General Assembly
15 congratulates and honors: the Girl Scout Movement; Girl
16 Scouts from Central Indiana; Girl Scouts of Greater Chicago,
17 Northwest Indiana; Girl Scouts of Kentuckiana; Girl Scouts of
18 Northern Indiana Michiana; and Girl Scouts of Southwest
19 Indiana for providing girls with a safe, inclusive, all-girl space
20 to hone their skills and leadership abilities.

21 SECTION 3. That the Principal Clerk of the House of
22 Representatives transmit copies of this resolution to Advocacy
23 and Community Relations Manager with Girl Scouts of Central
24 Indiana, Penni Sims.
