1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION recognizing dyslexia in
2 Hoosier youth.

3 *Whereas, Dyslexia is a language based learning disability*
4 *which results in people having difficulty with language skills*
5 *such as reading, spelling, writing, and speaking;*

6 *Whereas, While the causes of dyslexia are not clear, current*
7 *studies suggest that 85% of those with a reading disability have*
8 *dyslexia;*

9 *Whereas, Dyslexia is diagnosed through a formal evaluation,*
10 *conducted by trained school or outside specialists;*

11 *Whereas, Advocacy groups, including Bear Reading Center,*
12 *CAST Washington County, Children's Dyslexia Center,*
13 *Columbus READS, Decoding Dyslexia Indiana, Dyslexia*
14 *Institute of Indiana, Elliott Cox Racing, Fortune Academy,*
15 *Greenwood Public Library, International Dyslexia Association*
16 *Indiana Branch, Multisensory Education Solutions, and*
17 *Therese Rooney and the M.A. Rooney Foundation, along side*
