1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION recognizing Brigadier
2 General Felicia Brokaw.

3 *Whereas, On September 1, 2021, Colonel Felicia Brokaw*
4 *made history by being promoted to Brigadier General,*
5 *becoming the Indiana National Guard's first Black female*
6 *general;*

7 *Whereas, Brigadier General Brokaw joined the military 34*
8 *years ago to pay for college. She received her Bachelor of*
9 *Science in Computer Technology from Martin University. She*
10 *went on to receive a Master of Science in Management from*
11 *Oakland City University and a Master of Social Service in*
12 *Strategic Studies from the United States Army War College;*

13 *Whereas, Upon her promotion to Brigadier General, she*
14 *received a new assignment as Assistant Chief of Staff, J-4*
15 *(Wartime), United States Forces Korea, Seoul, AA;*

16 *Whereas, Throughout her service, Brigadier General Brokaw*
17 *has received a litany of awards, including the Bronze Star*
18 *Medal, Meritorious Service Medal with four Bronze Oak Leaf*
19 *Clusters, Army Commendation Medal with one Bronze Oak*
20 *Leaf Cluster, Indiana Distinguished Service Medal with Bronze*
21 *Star, Indiana Commendation Medal with Oak Leaf Cluster,*
22 *Indiana Long Service Medal with 30 Year Disk, and many*
23 *others;*

24 *Whereas, Brigadier General Brokaw said she hopes to lead,*
25 *mentor, and encourage other women of color to seek leadership*
26 *opportunities in the military and hopes her story will inspire*

2 *Whereas, It is fitting and proper to recognize Brigadier*
3 *General Felicia Brokaw for her long career of service to the*
4 *United States and her history-making promotion: Therefore,*

5 *Be it resolved by the House of Representatives*
6 *of the General Assembly of the State of Indiana,*
7 *the Senate concurring:*

8 SECTION 1. That the Indiana General Assembly recognizes
9 Brigadier General Felicia Brokaw upon becoming the Indiana
10 National Guard's first Black female general.
