3	Whereas, Eugene Joseph Heckman, 80, passed away
4	Friday, January 24, 2020, at Parkview Regional Medical
5	Center, Fort Wayne;
6	Whereas, Heckman served as Thorncreek Township Trustee
7	since 1971;
8	Whereas, Heckman was born on October 30, 1939, in
9	Thorncreek Twp., Whitley County, to Joseph H. and Grace
10	Heckman and graduated from Columbia City High School in
11	1957 before joining the U.S. Air Force, 122nd Air National
12	Guard Unit;
13	Whereas, Heckman was deployed to both France and North
14	Africa during the time of the Berlin Wall Crisis, and in
15	November 1963 was honorably discharged;
16	Whereas, Heckman married Karen Rose VanDeman June 21,
17	1959, and they called Tri-Lakes their home;
18	Whereas, In 1971 he bought his father's company, Heckman's
19	Sani-Service, providing solid trash removal, and operated the
20	business until he sold it in 1991;
21	Whereas, 1971 was the year he was elected Thorncreek
22	Township Trustee, finding his calling in life by serving the
23	people of the community. He was responsible for the operation
24	of the township's public services, including the Thorncreek

1	Twp. School, the Fire Department, cemeteries, and poor
2	assistance, and was key in the Tri-Lake Regional Sewer
3	District;
4	Whereas, Heckman served on the Whitley County School
5	Board for 24 years;
6	Whereas, A founding member of the Tri-Lakes Baptist
7	Church, Heckman served as a deacon and superintendent. As
8	a member of Gideons International, he helped distribute Bibles
9	throughout the area. He was a member of the National Solid
10	Waste Association Council for ten years and served as
11	President from 1993 to 1994;
12	Whereas, His service in government allowed him to meet
13	President George W. Bush, Senator Richard Lugar, Governor
14	Otis Bowen, Vice-President Dan Quayle, and others;
15	Whereas, Heckman is survived by his wife of 60 years, Karen;
16	three sons, David Heckman, Daniel Heckman, and Bruce
17	Beals; grandchildren, Katrina Straub, Hannah Heckman,
18	Moriah Heckman, Jason Shoemaker, Richard Shoemaker, and
19	Jaime Peppler; nine great-grandchildren; and a brother, Gary
20	Heckman; and
21	Whereas, Heckman was preceded in death by a sister,
22	Carolyn Boyd, and a great-grandson, Peyton Shoemaker:
