1           A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION recognizing the 125th  
2 anniversary of the Caroline Scott Harrison Chapter of the  
3 National Society Daughters of the American Revolution.

4           *Whereas, The Caroline Scott Harrison Chapter of the*  
5 *National Society Daughters of the American Revolution is the*  
6 *largest DAR chapter in Indiana and was named after the First*  
7 *Lady of the United States and first President General of the*  
8 *DAR;*

9           *Whereas, The Caroline Scott Harrison Chapter is the oldest*  
10 *DAR chapter in Indiana and was established on February 21,*  
11 *1894, just four years after the founding of the DAR;*

12           *Whereas, Mrs. C. C. Foster was appointed as Indiana's First*  
13 *State Regent and the following officers were elected to serve a*  
14 *growing organization: First Chapter Regent, Mrs. M. E.*  
15 *Vinton; Treasurer, Mrs. U. C. Atkins; Historian, Miss*  
16 *Katherine Merrill; and Secretary and Registrar, Mrs. J. R.*  
17 *Lilly;*

18           *Whereas, The Caroline Scott Harrison Chapter scanned and*  
19 *donated the data of approximately 4,600 pages of historic DAR*  
20 *scrapbooks from 1894 to 1940 to the Indiana State Library*  
21 *database, and has volunteered more than 125 hours to digitize*  
22 *World War I records for the Indiana Archives;*

23           *Whereas, The Caroline Scott Harrison Chapter works with*  
24 *the Indiana State Library to improve detailed searches in data*  
25 *asset management for employees and visitors at the Indiana*  
26 *State Library;*



1       *Whereas, The Caroline Scott Harrison Chapter has donated*  
 2       *thousands of dollars to support the United States armed forces*  
 3       *locally and abroad through tangible and monetary gifts,*  
 4       *including picnic tables at Camp Atterbury in central Indiana,*  
 5       *books, 28,200 individual commissary coupons for families, and*  
 6       *the proceeds from the sale of quilts, shawls, and Christmas*  
 7       *trees;*

8       *Whereas, The Caroline Scott Harrison Chapter completed a*  
 9       *full, award-winning restoration of Bell Cemetery, an Indiana*  
 10       *pioneer cemetery in Perry Township in Marion County,*  
 11       *including in-depth genealogy research to remember early*  
 12       *pioneers and inform visitors about the cemetery;*

13       *Whereas, The Caroline Scott Harrison Chapter provides the*  
 14       *care and restoration of historical monuments and artifacts*  
 15       *throughout central Indiana, including a \$20,000 restoration of*  
 16       *the Benjamin Harrison Battle Flag at the Indiana War*  
 17       *Memorial, a 100 year old DAR National Road Monument on*  
 18       *the Statehouse south lawn, and ongoing work at the Benjamin*  
 19       *Harrison Presidential Site in Indianapolis;*

20       *Whereas, The Caroline Scott Harrison Chapter continues a*  
 21       *legacy of historic preservation, education, and patriotism, and*  
 22       *the DAR remains a champion of these objectives throughout the*  
 23       *community; and*

24       *Whereas, The Caroline Scott Harrison Chapter celebrates its*  
 25       *125th anniversary on April 13, 2019: Therefore,*

26                       *Be it resolved by the House of Representatives*  
 27                       *of the General Assembly of the State of Indiana,*  
 28                       *the Senate concurring:*

29       SECTION 1. That the Indiana General Assembly recognizes  
 30       the 125th anniversary of the Caroline Scott Harrison Chapter of  
 31       the National Society Daughters of the American Revolution.

32       SECTION 2. That the Principal Clerk of the House of  
 33       Representatives transmit copies of this resolution to Charlotte  
 34       Blair, Regent of the Caroline Scott Harrison Chapter, NSDAR.
