4 *School in Pekin, Indiana, had a phenomenal 2017 season;*

5 *Whereas, On February 25, 2017, at Bankers Life*
6 *Fieldhouse in Indianapolis, Indiana, the Eastern High School*
7 *girls basketball team became the Class 2A state champions;*
