4 *Whereas, The World School Children's Art Exhibition is*
5 *held "to promote mutual understanding and friendship among*
6 *the young generation of the world through the exchange of*
7 *children's art work";*

8 *Whereas, The exhibition is organized by the Association for*
9 *Education through Art, the Republic of China, and the*
10 *Association of Formative Art Education for the Republic of*
11 *China;*

12 *Whereas, The exhibition is open to schoolchildren ages 6*
13 *through 15;*

14 *Whereas, Students from Whitko High School, South Whitley,*
15 *participated in the 48th World School Children's Art Exhibition*
16 *in Taipei in the Republic of China, receiving seven of 12*
17 *awards presented to the United States;*

18 *Whereas, Art students from all over the world submitted oil*
19 *paintings, watercolors, woodcut prints, pencil sketches, crayon*
20 *drawings, pastels, collages, etchings, graphic designs, and*
21 *various other art as entries into the 48th World School*
22 *Children's Art Exhibition;*

23 *Whereas, It is through international interactions such as the*
24 *48th World School Children's Art Exhibition that the youth of*
25 *our nation and state will learn to create a better, more*

2 *Whereas, Whitko High School art students have received 37*
3 *state, 43 national, and 141 international awards for their*
4 *exceptional artwork: Therefore,*

5 *Be it resolved by the House of Representatives*
6 *of the General Assembly of the State of Indiana,*
7 *the Senate concurring:*

8 SECTION 1. That the Indiana General Assembly
9 congratulates the Whitko High School art students who have
10 used their great creativity and their artistic expression to forge
11 new friendships and understanding across the world at the 48th
12 World School Children's Art Exhibition in Taipei in the
13 Republic of China.
