1	A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION recognizing September
2	1-7, 2019, as Natural Disaster Resiliency Week.

3 Whereas, Hazard mitigation is the effort to reduce loss of 4 life and property by lessening the impact of disasters and is 5 most effective when implemented under a comprehensive, 6 long-term mitigation plan;

Whereas, The Pre-Disaster Mitigation Grant Program,
administered by the Federal Emergency Management Agency
(FEMA), is designed to assist states and local communities in
implementing a sustained pre-disaster natural hazard
mitigation program;

Whereas, Federal legislation recently signed into law, the Disaster Recovery Reform Act, makes available new dollars for states and communities to undertake pre-disaster mitigation measures and creates new incentives for states to build resiliently;

Whereas, Since 1908, natural disasters have cost the country
more than \$1 trillion;

Whereas, Disasters affect local and state economies in lost
payrolls, lost sales and income taxes, and increased disaster
recovery times;

22 Whereas, According to a FEMA commissioned study 23 conducted by the National Institute of Building Sciences, every 24 \$1 spent on hazard mitigation provides the nation with \$6 in 25 future benefits;

1 2	Whereas, Twenty-five percent of small businesses that are impacted by a natural disaster never reopen their doors;
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3	Whereas, September is National Preparedness Month in
4	recognition of the need for all Americans to prepare and plan
5	for recovery after a disaster;
6	Whereas, Mitigation planning is a key process used to break
7	the cycle of disaster damage, reconstruction, and repeated
8	damage;
9	Whereas, Effective pre-disaster mitigation reduces the
10	demand for relief services on volunteer organizations such as
11	disaster rescue and recovery teams, along with food banks and
12	homeless shelters who serve our communities by changing their
13	operations to provide additional services to those affected by
14	disaster;
15	Whereas, Countless brave men and women selflessly provide
16	aid in a disaster as first responders; and
17	Whereas, The National Council of Insurance Legislators
18	encourages communities throughout the country to build
19	resiliently and develop long-range mitigation strategies for
20	protecting people and property from future hazard events:
