13	rallied to play its best basketball behind the efforts of Maddie
14	Lawrence in the Speedway Regional the next Saturday,
15	defeating Covenant Christian and Triton Central;
16	Whereas, The Lady Falcons continued on their winning ways
17	through the semi-state game, where they defeated a very good

20	Central Noble, found Shelby Miller back in the game;
