7 *High School, has been awarded a Power of Children Award*  
8 *from the Children's Museum of Indianapolis for her work to*

12 *reward students in grades 6 through 11 who are improving the*  
13 *lives of others through selfless commitment to service and the*  
14 *betterment of society. Elizabeth is one of only six winners in the*  
15 *nation;*

16           *Whereas, Alex Equihua earned the Indiana High School*  
17 *Athletic Association (IHSAA) Girls Volleyball Mental Attitude*  
18 *Award;*

19           *Whereas, At the conclusion of each state championship*  
20 *match, the IHSAA Executive Committee presents an award for*  
21 *mental attitude to an outstanding senior participant. The*  
22 *recipient of this award, who was nominated by her principal*  
23 *and coach, excels in mental attitude, scholarship, leadership,*  
24 *and athletic ability in volleyball;*

26           *Whereas, Jerome Flewelling was named the 2018 Indiana*  
27 *Teacher of the Year by a committee of past recipients of the*

2       *Whereas, Jerome, an Advanced Placement physics,*  
 3       *mechanics, and chemistry teacher at Crown Point High School,*  
 4       *has been teaching for 21 years. He has received numerous*  
 5       *awards and recognitions throughout his career, including Most*  
 6       *Influential Teacher, Crown Point Teacher of the Year, and*  
 7       *Outstanding Performance of Theatre Production. He also was*  
 8       *a Spell Bowl sponsor;*

9       *Whereas, Principal Chip Pettit was named the IHSPA's 2017*  
 10       *Administrator of the Year for his support of student journalism;*

11       *Whereas, Under Principal Pettit, Crown Point High School*  
 12       *journalism students and advisers have been able to thrive in an*  
 13       *era of increasing censorship;*

14       *Whereas, Superintendent Teresa A. Eineman was honored as*  
 15       *a fellow with the Society of Innovators for her systems-based*  
 16       *approach, which created change in Northwest Indiana;*

17       *Whereas, Superintendent Eineman implemented a continuous*  
 18       *improvement model, applying proven business practices to*  
 19       *education that put Crown Point Community School*  
 20       *Corporation among elite performing districts in Indiana and*  
 21       *the nation. This transformation, occurring over 12 years, was*  
 22       *inspired by the "Good to Great" classic leading to more*  
 23       *accountability, enhanced performance, and new ideas from her*  
 24       *team of principals and staff; and*

25       *Whereas, These individuals and countless others have*  
 26       *contributed to making Crown Point High School and the*  
 27       *surrounding community a shining beacon in Northwest Indiana*
