**DIGEST OF INTRODUCED RESOLUTION**

**Citations Affected:** Article 6, Section 6 of the Constitution of the State of Indiana.

**Synopsis:** Town and city court judges. Provides that county, township, and town residency requirements prescribed by Article 6, Section 6 of the Indiana Constitution do not apply to city or town court judges. This proposed amendment has not been previously agreed to by a general assembly.

**Effective:** This proposed amendment must be agreed to by two consecutive general assemblies and ratified by a majority of the state's voters voting on the question to be effective.

A JOINT RESOLUTION proposing an amendment to Article 6, Section 6 of the Constitution of the State of Indiana.

*Be it resolved by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:*

1 SECTION 1. The following amendment to the Constitution of the  
2 State of Indiana is proposed and agreed to by this, the One Hundred  
3 Twenty-Second General Assembly of the State of Indiana, and is  
4 referred to the next General Assembly for reconsideration and  
5 agreement.

6 SECTION 2. ARTICLE 6, SECTION 6 OF THE CONSTITUTION  
7 OF THE STATE OF INDIANA IS AMENDED TO READ AS  
8 FOLLOWS: Section 6. **(a)** All county, township, and town officers,  
9 shall reside within their respective counties, townships, and towns; and  
10 shall keep their respective offices at such places therein, and perform  
11 such duties, as may be directed by law.

12 **(b) This section does not apply to the judge of a city or town**  
13 **court.**
