DIGEST OF INTRODUCED RESOLUTION

Citations Affected: Article 2, Section 14 of the Constitution of the State of Indiana.

Synopsis: Deceased absentee voters. Provides that the general assembly may provide that if a voter who legally returns a voted ballot before election day subsequently dies before election day, the voter's vote shall be counted.

Effective: This proposed amendment must be agreed to by two consecutive general assemblies and ratified by a majority of the state's voters voting on the question to be effective.

A JOINT RESOLUTION proposing an amendment to Article 2, Section 14 of the Constitution of the State of Indiana concerning elections.

Be it resolved by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1	SECTION 1. The following amendment to the Constitution of the

5	SECTION 2. ARTICLE 2, SECTION 14 OF THE CONSTITUTION
6	OF THE STATE OF INDIANA IS AMENDED TO READ AS
7	FOLLOWS: Section 14. (a) General elections shall be held on the first
8	Tuesday after the first Monday in November.
9	(b) The General Assembly may provide by law for the election of all
10	judges of courts of general and appellate jurisdiction, by an election to
11	be held for such officers only, at which time no other officer shall be
12	voted for.

(c) The General Assembly shall provide for the registration of all 1 2 persons entitled to vote. 3

- (d) The General Assembly may provide by law that if a voter:
- (1) legally returns a voted ballot before election day; and
 - (2) subsequently dies before election day;
