1           A HOUSE RESOLUTION memorializing Erica Lee  
2 Frazier Stum.

3           *Whereas, Erica Lee Frazier Stum was born on July 9, 1985,*  
4 *to Sue Schuppert and Steve Frazier;*

5           *Whereas, Erica passed away December 27, 2018;*

6           *Whereas, Erica earned a bachelor's degree in engineering*  
7 *and technology education from Ball State University in 2007*  
8 *and a master's degree in special education in 2013;*

9           *Whereas, Erica devoted her teaching career to enriching the*  
10 *lives of children by promoting STEM and robotics in Indiana;*

11           *Whereas, Erica worked extensively with*  
12 *Engineering/Technology Educators of Indiana, taught in*

1 *southern Indiana, and later became the STEM director at the*  
2 *Paramount School of Excellence in Indianapolis in addition to*  
3 *being an educator;*

4 *Whereas, Erica fostered a robotics program at the*  
5 *Paramount School for Excellence that earned multiple state*  
6 *titles and competed in multiple world competitions;*

7 *Whereas, In 2012 Erica was first diagnosed with stage 1B2*  
8 *cervical cancer at the age of 27;*

9 *Whereas, Erica was deemed incurable after three years of*  
10 *aggressive cancer treatment and was told that she would live*  
11 *her life with cancer;*

12 *Whereas, Erica was a dedicated Cervivor Ambassador and*  
13 *volunteer for the American Cancer Society;*

14 *Whereas, Erica spent the last few years of her life promoting*  
15 *awareness and prevention of HPV and was recognized with the*  
16 *Indiana Immunization Coalition HPV Champion Award; and*

17 *Whereas, In addition to being a devoted wife, mother,*  
18 *daughter, sister, and friend, Erica dedicated her life to the*  
19 *prevention of cervical cancer, especially for those in the state*  
20 *of Indiana, where she was born, raised, lived, and died:*  
21 *Therefore,*

22 *Be it resolved by the House of Representatives of the*  
23 *General Assembly of the State of Indiana:*

24 SECTION 1. That the Indiana House of Representatives  
25 expresses its deepest sympathy to the family of Erica Lee  
26 Frazier Stum and recognizes her achievements and positive  
27 impact in the state of Indiana.
