A HOUSE RESOLUTION urging the Legislative Council to assign to the Interim Study Committee on Tax and Fiscal Policy the task of studying ways to maximize the amount of federal assistance provided to Indiana.

Whereas, The federal government has made a significant amount of federal money available to the states throughout 2020 and 2021 in response to the COVID-19 pandemic;

Whereas, It is critical that the state of Indiana maximizes the
amount of federal money provided to the state;

Whereas, It is necessary for the Interim Study Committee on Tax and Fiscal Policy to examine the state laws and policies affecting Indiana's receipt of federal money; and

Tax and Fiscal Policy to review Indiana's participation in the SNAP program, the Medicaid program, the earned income tax credit program, the TANF program, and other federally funded programs through which Indiana residents receive assistance to identify and recommend programmatic outreach improvements to ensure the maximization and utilization of Indiana's participation in these federal programs: Therefore,

Be it resolved by the House of Representatives of the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

SECTION 1. That the House of Representatives urges the Legislative Council to assign to the Interim Study Committee on Tax and Fiscal Policy the task of studying ways to maximize the amount of federal assistance provided to Indiana;

SECTION 2. That copies of this resolution be transmitted by the Principal Clerk of the House of Representatives to each member of the Personnel Subcommittee of the Legislative Council and the executive director of the Legislative Services Agency.
