January 25, 2018, read first time and referred to Committee on Roads and Transportation.

February 22, 2018, reported — Do Pass.

A HOUSE RESOLUTION urging the legislative council to assign to the appropriate committee the topics of the use of an unlawful electronic communication device while driving and automated traffic control in construction zones.

Whereas, Safety on our roads and highways is of the utmost
importance to all Hoosiers;

Whereas, Issues that are of special interest to every citizen include driver distractions and the use of electronic communication devices while driving, work zone safety, and reducing speed in work zones; and

Whereas, In order to provide a workable solution to the pressing issues, there should be further study of these two issues: Therefore,

6	automated traffic control in construction zones.
