1 A HOUSE RESOLUTION honoring Representative Chuck
2 Goodrich.

3 *Whereas, Representative Chuck Goodrich, who was first*
4 *elected to represent the citizens of House District 29 in 2018,*
5 *will be leaving the House Chamber for the last time at the end*
6 *of the 2024 Legislative Session;*

7 *Whereas, During his time in the House of Representatives,*
8 *Representative Goodrich has served as the Chair of the K-12*
9 *Subcommittee of the House Ways and Means Committee and as*
10 *a member of the House Education and House Employment,*
11 *Labor and Pensions Committees;*

12 *Whereas, Representative Goodrich has focused on education*
13 *and support for young Hoosiers through expanding scholarship*
14 *opportunities, creating a senior-youth mentor pilot program,*

1 *which aims to provide struggling students with a role model at*
2 *school, reallocating existing state funds to proven workforce*
3 *programs so Hoosiers can increase their certifications, earn*
4 *stackable credentials and secure higher-paying jobs in*
5 *high-demand fields, establishing a grant for robotics*
6 *competition teams to increase interest and improve skills in*
7 *science, technology, engineering, and mathematics, and*
8 *expanding access to the Temporary Assistance for Needy*
9 *Families program;*

10 *Whereas, Representative Goodrich is also proud of the bill*
11 *he authored that increased the special death benefit for public*
12 *safety workers who die in the line of duty;*

13 *Whereas, In addition to his service as a state representative,*
14 *Representative Goodrich serves as the president and CEO of*
15 *Gaylor Electric, Inc., an electrical design-build contractor that*
16 *employs approximately 2,000 men and women throughout 13*
17 *offices in five states across the country, including seven Indiana*
18 *locations. During his tenure, Gaylor Electric created more than*
19 *1,000 jobs;*

20 *Whereas, He helped open the Gaylor Electric Crossing*
21 *School of Business and Entrepreneurship satellite campus, an*
22 *alternative, state-accredited high school for at-risk students at*
23 *the Gaylor Noblesville hub, and he is a Purdue University*
24 *Distinguished Technology Alumnus and member of the Indiana*
25 *Department of Workforce Development's Region 5 Workforce*
26 *Development Board;*

27 *Whereas, Over the years, Representative Goodrich has been*
28 *recognized for his professional leadership and philanthropic*
29 *passion by winning the James J. Leonard Memorial Award,*
30 *Business Person of the Year for the City of Noblesville, the ABC*
31 *Outstanding Chapter Support Award, and the Gaylor Electric*
32 *Optimist Award, and he serves as chair of David's Well;*

33 *Whereas, Representative Goodrich is married to his wife of*
34 *30 years, Tricia, with whom he has four children and one*
35 *grandson, and he and his wife happily reside in Noblesville;*
