

## HOUSE RESOLUTION No.

A HOUSE RESOLUTION urging Governor Holcomb to reaffirm September as Brain Aneurysm Awareness Month.

Whereas, A brain aneurysm, also referred to as a cerebral aneurysm or intracranial aneurysm, is a weak bulging spot on the wall of a brain artery;

6 Whereas, Although relatively uncommon, ruptured 7 aneurysms are very serious and usually associated with a high 8 mortality rate and disability;

Whereas, The blood flow within the artery pounds against the thinned portion of the wall, and bulging spots form that begin to swell outward;

Whereas, Pressure may cause this aneurysm to rupture, allowing blood to escape into the space around the brain,

2	Whereas, Survivors of brain aneurysms face many
3	challenges on their road to recovery, including physical
4	challenges, emotional challenges, depression, and potential
5	deficits;
6	Whereas, Only through knowledge and understanding will
7	we be better able to help survivors and ensure that all of their
8	rights are protected;
9	Whereas, Governor Eric Holcomb first recognized
10	September as Brain Aneurysm Awareness Month in 2018; and
11	Whereas, It is critically important to help raise awareness of
12	brain aneurysms, including methods of early detection and
13	treatment: Therefore,
14	Be it resolved by the House of Representatives of the
15	General Assembly of the State of Indiana:
16	SECTION 1. That the Indiana House of Representatives
17	urges Governor Eric Holcomb to reaffirm September as Brain
18	Aneurysm Awareness Month to raise awareness and better help
19	survivors.
20	SECTION 2. That the Principal Clerk of the House of
21	Representatives shall transmit copies of this resolution to
22	Governor Eric Holcomb, the Brain Aneurysm Foundation, and
23	Raymond Morefield.
