4	Whereas, On April 15, 2021, eight individuals lost their lives
5	in a mass shooting at a FedEx facility in Indianapolis;
6	Whereas, Matthew Ross Alexander was a beloved son,
7	brother, grandson, nephew, cousin, and friend. Matt led by
8	example, rather than words. He was known for his laid-back
9	nature, sense of humor, and heart of gold. Matt graduated from
10	Avon High School in 2007 and attended Butler University. He
11	began working at FedEx SmartPost in 2011 and had recently
12	earned his 10-year recognition award. His most recent position
13	was Line Haul Coordinator. As a dedicated, hardworking
14	employee, Matt was very well respected by his colleagues and
15	anyone who had the pleasure of working with him. Matt was an



avid sports enthusiast and was blessed with the ability to play
just about any sport. Matt is survived by his parents, Brad and
Debbie (Pickel) Alexander, sister, Michelle Alexander,
grandparents, Eva Pickel and Ron and Jeanne Alexander, and
many aunts, uncles, and cousins. Matt made an impact on
everyone he met and will be missed by all;
