A HOUSE RESOLUTION honoring Assistant Adjutant General-Air, Brigadier General Patrick R. Renwick upon his retirement.

Whereas, Brigadier General Patrick R. Renwick is the Assistant Adjutant General—Air, and Commander Indiana Air National Guard, Stout Field, Indianapolis. He is the senior advisor to the Adjutant General and is responsible for organizing, training, and equipping the approximately 2,000 Indiana airmen, state employees, and contractors serving primarily at the 122nd Fighter Wing and 181st Intelligence Wing;

Whereas, Prior to his current assignment, Brig. Gen. Renwick served as the chief of staff for the Indiana Air National Guard. He preceded these roles as commander of the 122nd Fighter Wing in Fort Wayne, Indiana, with the responsibility to

2	firepower and agile combat support to combatant commanders
3	worldwide;
4	Whereas, Brig. Gen. Renwick earned his commission from
5	United States Air Force Officer Training School in 1989, and
6	immediately attended undergraduate pilot training at Vance Air
7	Force Base, Oklahoma;
8	Whereas, In 1998, he transitioned to the Indiana Air
9	National Guard, 181st Fighter Wing, Terre Haute, Indiana,
10	where he served as an F-16 pilot, Aircraft Maintenance
11	Squadron commander, Air Support Operations Squadron
12	commander, and vice commander of the 181st Intelligence
13	Wing;
14	Whereas, While a colonel, he deployed as the command joint
15	inspector general for Combined Joint Interagency Task Force
16	435 from March 2013 to October 2013, at Camp Phoenix,
17	Afghanistan;
18	Whereas, He is a command pilot with over 3,300 flying
19	hours and six deployments in support of Operations Vigilant
20	Warrior, Southern Watch, Northern Watch, Iraqi Freedom, and
21	Enduring Freedom;
22	Whereas, Brig. Gen. Renwick's decorations include the
23	Legion of Merit, Defense Meritorious Service Medal,
24	Meritorious Service Medal with oak leaf cluster, Air Medal
25	with oak leaf cluster, Aerial Achievement Medal with silver oak
26	leaf cluster, Air Force Commendation Medal with oak leaf
27	cluster, and Air Force Achievement Medal; and
28	Whereas, It is fitting and proper to recognize Brigadier
29	General Patrick R. Renwick for his long career of service to the
30	United States: Therefore,
