3           *Whereas, Young-Hee Yedinak, of Indianapolis, passed away*  
4           *February 8, 2020, at 64 years old;*

5           *Whereas, Young-Hee was born in Seoul, South Korea, and*  
6           *has lived in both Indonesia and Vietnam prior to moving to the*  
7           *United States, where she settled in Indianapolis and called it*  
8           *home;*

9           *Whereas, Young-Hee was an award winning media*  
10          *professional, and she was a bridge builder who had a passion*  
11          *about bringing people together to create an impact in the*  
12          *community;*

13          *Whereas, Young-Hee had more than three decades of*

1 *television experience in promotion, production, and community*  
 2 *affairs, largely through her work with WTHR-TV, Channel 13*  
 3 *in Indianapolis;*

4 *Whereas, During her extensive career, Young-Hee won*  
 5 *several awards for her media work, such as Emmy Awards from*  
 6 *the National Association of Television Arts and Sciences,*  
 7 *Spectrum Awards from the Indiana Broadcasters Association,*  
 8 *and Community Impact Awards from the Indiana Associated*  
 9 *Press, and she was also a board member for many Indianapolis*  
 10 *community organizations;*

11 *Whereas, Young-Hee was passionate about her Asian*  
 12 *heritage, having served as the association president in the*  
 13 *Asian American Alliance, and serving as the vice president of*  
 14 *the Korean American Association;*

15 *Whereas, Young-Hee had a love of travel, visiting more than*  
 16 *15 countries, and she spent much of her time exercising her*  
 17 *fluency in four languages. Through all places she visited, she*  
 18 *often spoke of her love for the Midwest and of her family home*  
 19 *in Michigan, which she described as her happy place; and*

20 *Whereas, Young-Hee was an active member of Holy Spirit at*  
 21 *Geist Catholic Church, located in Fishers. She is survived by*  
 22 *her parents, Zung-Kyong Kang and Yoon-Hee Kim; her*  
 23 *husband, Jim; daughter, Tracy; son-in-law, Nick; grandson,*  
 24 *Ben; brothers, Michael Young-Jae, Steven Young-Chan, and*  
 25 *Kenneth Young-Hoon; sisters-in-law, Carol, Stephanie, and*  
 26 *Monica; niece, Gina; nephews, Jonathan, Andrew, Christopher,*  
 27 *and Matthew; and god-daughter, Cybele: Therefore,*
