1 A HOUSE RESOLUTION congratulating the Frankton
2 High School boys basketball team.

3 *Whereas, The Frankton High School boys basketball team is*
4 *a state champion;*

5 *Whereas, On March 25, 2017, at Bankers Life Fieldhouse in*
6 *Indianapolis, the Eagles defeated Crawford County High*
7 *School 60-32 to give the school its first state basketball*
8 *championship in history;*

9 *Whereas, The game was outstanding defensively with*
10 *Frankton coming up with 19 steals, an all-class championship*
11 *game record;*

12 *Whereas, The 28-point margin of victory also eclipsed the*

1 *previous Class 2A record by one point;*

2 *Whereas, Frankton's continuous pressure forced Crawford*
 3 *County into 13 turnovers in the first 16 minutes and 25 for the*
 4 *game;*

5 *Whereas, Maurice Knight, who scored 23 points in the*
 6 *championship game, finished second on Frankton's all-time*
 7 *scoring list with 1,313 points and broke the single season*
 8 *scoring record with 625 points this season;*

9 *Whereas, Maurice Knight also scored 35 points to lead*
 10 *Frankton in the semi-state championship game;*

11 *Whereas, Keegan Freestone was named the winner of the*
 12 *Arthur L. Trester Mental Attitude Award in Class 2A boys*
 13 *basketball by the members of the Indiana High School Athletic*
 14 *Association executive committee;*

15 *Whereas, Keegan Freestone, the son of Brad and Katie*
 16 *Freestone of Alexandria, will be attending Indiana University*
 17 *where he plans to study accounting and finance;*

18 *Whereas, An outstanding student, Keegan Freestone ranks*
 19 *third academically in his senior class and is the vice president*
 20 *of the National Honor Society, a Frankton Eagle Mentor, and*
 21 *student council member; and*

22 *Whereas, Outstanding accomplishments such as this deserve*
