

SENATE BILL No. 2

DIGEST OF SB 2 (Updated January 13, 2021 1:52 pm - DI 110)

Citations Affected: IC 20-43.

Synopsis: Funding for virtual instruction in public schools. Establishes a definition of "virtual instruction" for purposes of determining a school corporation's basic tuition support using the 2021 spring count of average daily membership (ADM).

Effective: January 1, 2021 (retroactive).

SENATE BILL No. 2

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning education.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1	SECTION 1. IC 20-43-1-33 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE
2	AS A NEW SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
3	JANUARY 1, 2021 (RETROACTIVE)]: Sec. 33. (a) This section
4	applies only for the purposes of determining a school corporation's
5	basic tuition support under IC 20-43-6-3 using the 2021 spring
6	count of ADM as described in IC 20-43-4-9(a).
7	(b) "Virtual instruction" means instruction that is provided in
8	an interactive learning environment created through technology in
9	which the student is separated from a teacher by time or space, or
0	both. However, the term does not include instruction that is
1	provided to a student who meets the following requirements:
2	(1) The student was not enrolled in a:
3	(A) virtual education program (as defined in IC 20-19-9-1);
4	(B) dedicated virtual education school; or
5	(C) virtual charter school;
6	on the date fixed in February 2020 by the state board for a
7	count of students under IC 20-43-4-3.



1	(2) The student was not enrolled in a:
2	(A) dedicated virtual education school; or
3	(B) virtual charter school;
4	on the date fixed in February 2021 by the state board for a
5	count of students under IC 20-43-4-3.
6	(c) This section expires July 1, 2021.
7	SECTION 2. An emergency is declared for this act.
