SENATE BILL No. 5

A BILL FOR AN ACT concerning estate planning.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

SECTION 1. [EFFECTIVE UPON PASSAGE] (a) As used in this SECTION, "courts and the judiciary committee" refers to the interim study committee on courts and the judiciary established under IC 2-5-1.3-4.

(b) As used in this SECTION, "study committee" means an interim study committee established by IC 2-5-1.3-4.

(c) The general assembly urges the legislative council to assign to the courts and the judiciary committee or another appropriate study committee the topic of the Uniform Powers of Appointment Act, as approved and recommended by the National Conference of Commissioners on Uniform State Laws.

12 (d) If the legislative council assigns the topic described in 13 subsection (c) to the courts and the judiciary committee or another 14 appropriate study committee, the courts and the judiciary 15 committee or the study committee shall complete the study 16 required by this SECTION and report its findings and 17 recommendations, if any, to the legislative council before
