### DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

**Citations Affected:** IC 35-46-3.

**Synopsis:** Animal fighting contests. Makes attending an animal fighting contest a Level 6 felony. Repeals the law that makes it cruelty to an animal, a Class A misdemeanor, for a person to attend a fighting contest involving animals.

**Effective:** July 1, 2014.

# SENATE BILL No. 6



A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning criminal law and procedure.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:*

1 SECTION 1. IC 35-46-3-9, AS AMENDED BY P.L.158-2013,  
2 SECTION 560, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS  
3 [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2014]: Sec. 9. A person who knowingly or  
4 intentionally:  
5 (1) promotes or stages an animal fighting contest;  
6 (2) uses an animal in a fighting contest; or  
7 (3) attends an animal fighting contest; ~~having an animal in the~~  
8 ~~person's possession;~~  
9 commits a Level 6 felony.

10 SECTION 2. IC 35-46-3-10 IS REPEALED [EFFECTIVE JULY 1,  
11 2014]. ~~Sec. 10. A person who knowingly or intentionally attends a~~  
12 ~~fighting contest involving animals commits cruelty to an animal; a~~  
13 ~~Class A misdemeanor. However, except for a conviction under section~~  
14 ~~† of this chapter, the offense is a Level 6 felony if the person has a prior~~  
15 ~~unrelated conviction under this chapter.~~
