DIGEST OF SB 12 (Updated January 7, 2015 1:36 pm - DI 84)

Citations Affected: IC 33-38.

Synopsis: Judicial retirement age. Requires justices of the supreme court and judges of the court of appeals to retire at 80 years of age. (Under current law, justices and court of appeals judges must retire at 75 years of age.)

Effective: July 1, 2015.

Additions: Whenever a new statutory provision is being enacted (or a new constitutional provision adopted), the text of the new provision will appear in **this style type**. Also, the word **NEW** will appear in that style type in the introductory clause of each SECTION that adds a new provision to the Indiana Code or the Indiana Constitution.

Conflict reconciliation: Text in a statute in *this style type* or *this style type* reconciles conflicts between statutes enacted by the 2014 Regular Session and 2014 Second Regular Technical Session of the General Assembly.

SENATE BILL No. 12

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning courts and court officers.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

SECTION 1. IC 33-38-13-8 IS AMENDED TO READ .	AS
FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2015]: Sec. 8. (a) Every justice	of
the supreme court and judge of the court of appeals shall retire	at
seventy-five (75) eighty (80) years of age.	

(b) Notwithstanding subsection (a), the supreme court may authorize retired justices and judges to perform temporary judicial duties in any state court.
