Synopsis: Residency requirements for police and firefighters. Allows a member of a city police or fire department to reside within a county located outside Indiana that is contiguous to the county in which the city is located.

SENATE BILL No. 12

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning local government.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1	SECTION 1. IC 36-8-4-2, AS AMENDED BY P.L.65-2008,
2	SECTION 1, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
3	JULY 1, 2017]: Sec. 2. (a) Members of the police and fire departments
4	must reside in Indiana within:
5	(1) the county in which the city is located; or
6	(2) a county that is:
7	(A) contiguous to the county in which the city is located; and
8	(B) located inside or outside Indiana.
9	(b) In a consolidated city, a member who was residing outside the
0	county on January 1, 1975, is exempt from subsection (a).
1	(c) A city with a population of less than seven thousand five
2	hundred (7,500) may adopt an ordinance that requires a member of the
3	city's police or fire department to comply with the following:
4	(1) Reside within the county in which the city is located.
5	(2) Have adequate means of transportation into the city.
6	(3) Maintain in the member's residence telephone service with the
7	city.

1	(d) This subsection applies to a city that:
2	(1) has a population of less than seven thousand five hundred
3	(7,500); and
4	(2) adopted an ordinance to establish the requirements described
5	in this subsection before September 1, 1984.
6	A city may require, in addition to the requirements of subsection (c),
7	that a member of the police or fire department reside within the city
8	until the member has served in the department for five (5) years.
9	(e) An ordinance adopted under subsection (c) or described in
10	subsection (d)(2) may not require a member of a city's police or fire
11	department to reside within the county in which the city is located if the
12	member resides outside the county on the date the ordinance is
13	adopted.
