

SENATE BILL No. 17

DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 35-31.5-2; IC 35-46-1-4.5.

Synopsis: Unattended child in car. Makes it a Class C infraction to leave an unsupervised child in a motor vehicle unless the motor vehicle is located at the person's residence and the engine is off.

Effective: July 1, 2014.

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning criminal law and procedure.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

- 7 [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2014]: **Sec. 342.5. "Unsupervised", for**
- 8 **purposes of IC 35-46-1-4.5, has the meaning set forth in**
- 9 **IC 35-46-1-4.5.**
- 10 SECTION 3. IC 35-46-1-4.5 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE
- 11 AS A **NEW** SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY
- 12 1, 2014]: **Sec. 4.5. (a) As used in this section, "care" includes care**
- 13 **assumed:**
- 14 **(1) voluntarily; or**
- 15 **(2) because of a legal obligation.**
- 16 **(b) As used in this section, "unsupervised" means not under the**



- 1 supervision of a person at least twelve (12) years of age.
2 (c) A person having the care of a child less than six (6) years of
3 age may not leave the child unsupervised in a motor vehicle.
4 (d) It is a defense to an action under this section that the:
5 (1) motor vehicle was located at the person's residence; and
6 (2) engine of the motor vehicle was off.
7 (e) A person who violates this section commits a Class C
8 infraction.
