DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 20-51-4-12.

Synopsis: Choice scholarship information. Requires the department of education, before the end of the fall semester and before the end of the spring semester of each school year, to distribute to each school corporation the: (1) name of each eligible school in which an eligible choice scholarship student who has legal settlement in the school corporation is enrolled; and (2) number of the eligible choice scholarship students who are enrolled in each eligible school for the current school year.
