DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 9-21-8-43.5.

Synopsis: Moving traffic violations. Provides that a person may not drive a vehicle while holding an animal.

Effective: July 1, 2017.

SENATE BILL No. 32

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning motor vehicles.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1 SECTION 1. IC 9-21-8-43.5 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE
2 AS A **NEW** SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY
3 1, 2017]: **Sec. 43.5. A person may not drive a vehicle while:**
4 **(1) holding an animal in the person's lap or arms; or**
5 **(2) an animal is situated next to or between the legs of the**
6 **person so as to do either of the following:**
7 **(A) Obstruct the view of the person to the front or sides of**
8 **the vehicle.**
9 **(B) Interfere with the person's control over the driving**
10 **mechanism of the vehicle.**
