### SENATE BILL No. 32

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning motor vehicles.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1	SECTION 1. IC 9-21-8-43.5 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE
2	AS A NEW SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY
3	1, 2017]: Sec. 43.5. A person may not drive a vehicle while:
4	(1) holding an animal in the person's lap or arms; or
5	(2) an animal is situated next to or between the legs of the
6	person so as to do either of the following:
7	(A) Obstruct the view of the person to the front or sides of
8	the vehicle.
9	(B) Interfere with the person's control over the driving
10	mechanism of the vehicle.
